<p>Write your own sentences about the UK using these Year 6 spelling words:</p> <p><b>environment, foreign, government, language, neighbour, parliament, sacrifice, soldier, symbol, temperature,</b></p> <p>Remember punctuation and to make your writing as interesting as possible.</p>	<p><u>Prime and Composite numbers</u></p> <p>Draw a hundreds square. Colour the prime numbers in red and the composite numbers in blue.</p> 	<p><u>Geography/History/RE</u></p> <p>Find out about the 4 different Patron Saints. Who were they? Why are they famous? Can you write their story? Can you draw or paint a picture of them?</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Every country has its own special features and characteristics e.g., landmarks, national dishes, sports. Can you identify any features or characteristics for each UK country? Create a poster to show them.</p>
<p>In class, we have been learning about William Shakespeare. Choose one of his famous plays and rewrite it as a story. You can illustrate it too! Remember to use paragraphs, a range of punctuation and Year 6 vocabulary!</p> 	<p><u>Fractions, Decimals and Percentages</u></p> <p>Make and design your own puzzle that connects equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages e.g. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> 0.25 25%</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Research a famous British sport such as: tennis, rugby or football. When and where did it start? Create a fact file of information on it.</p>	<p><u>Design and Technology/Art</u></p> <p>Create a 3d sculpture of a monument in the UK. Can you then research it and explain the history?</p>
<p>Find out about a Welsh, Scottish, English or Irish myth or legend. Re-tell the story in your own words!</p> 	<p><u>Area and Perimeter</u></p> <p>You may need help from an adult - using a tape measure, measure the perimeter of each room in your house. Can you then work out the area of each room too? Design a bird's eye view plan of your house including a scale.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>Find out about the history of British Kings and Queens. Can you create a 'line of succession' but going back as far as you can to show our Kings and Queens?</p>	<p><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>Bake your own UK themed cake, cookies or biscuits OR a traditional British dish. It could be themed like our flag! Write the recipe in your homework book.</p>
<p>Choose a famous British person linked to history, music, books, sport or anything that interests you! Research their life and write a biography about them. Remember to include: a title, introduction, sub-headings with paragraphs of information in chronological order, a conclusion and pictures.</p>	<p><u>Data Handling</u></p> <p>Research the monthly average temperature for the UK for each month of the year. Order the months from the warmest to the coldest. Do the same for Brazil. Create a bar chart to show your findings for each month.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Research and compare the wildlife and climate in the UK and in South America. What are they like? What is similar and what is different? Decide how you would like to show your findings.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Research a famous British composer. What music did they compose? Find out about their life and why they are famous.</p>
