- When you started school

Challenge

Can you make a timeline for an adult in your family?

<u>Art - Paul Klee</u>

Paul Klee is famous for using a grid to draw his pictures. Can



you use a ruler and a pencil to draw a grid where all the lines are equal distances apart?

Challenge - Can you use the lines on the grid to draw a picture of one or more houses, like Paul Klee did?

Topic Amelia Earhart

Amelia Earhart was the first woman to fly across the Atlantic.

Can you find a map of the world and track her flight.

Where did she leave from? Where did she arrive?



Challenge

She planned to go around the world. Can you find and list all the countries she planned to go to.

PE - Sprinting

Measure out track with a start and end line.

Time yourself to see how long it takes you to walk it, jog it, run it.

Now do some stretches and repeat. Are you any faster?

Challenge - can you make up a warm up routine we could use in PE lessons. Include some stretches and gentle exercises.
