

From your garden, or from a walk, collect a range of different stones. Have a go at testing each of the rocks and fill in the table below.




# Global Warming

Global warming is the rising in temperature of the earth's atmosphere.

It is said that by the time babies that are born today are 80 years old the earth will be 6 degrees warmer than it is now.

Not all global warming is bad, the earth needs to be kept at 16 degrees so that plants, animals and humans can live. The more greenhouse gases we make though, the thicker the blanket around the Earth gets. This results in more heat being trapped which causes the Earth to get hotter. This is when global warming is bad.





The earth's rays enter the earth's atmosphere as light and heat energy.

Some of the heat escapes.

Some of the heat is reflected from the earth's surface.

Some of the heat gets trapped by the layer of greenhouse gases.

The earth gets hotter as a result.
