	Write the days of the week in cursive handwriting. Remember not to join the capital letters!	Write the words for the numbers 1-10.	<b><u>Art</u></b> Create a piece of art based around the Spring season.	<b><u>Music</u></b> Vivaldi created a piece of music entitled Seasons. You can listen to part of it on Youtube. Each season is represented by a different part of the music. Can you create your own piece of music to represent one of the seasons?
	Write what you like and don't like about your favourite story book.	Can you draw a picture to represent counting in 2s? (You might draw pairs of socks for example). Make sure you label with the numbers.	<b><u>Science</u></b> What are the four seasons? Can you create a seasons wheel with one section of the wheel for each season? Label each of the four seasons and draw pictures to represent each season.	<b><u>Science</u></b> Go on a plant hunt. Make a list of all the plants (trees, bushes, flowers etc) that you can identify.
	Write a few sentences about your Easter holidays. Remember to use your phonics to help you spell the words and try to remember capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.	Can you follow a recipe to make a cake/ cookies/ dinner? Make sure you weigh out all the ingredients carefully!	<b><u>History</u></b> Find out about a famous person who is from our local area. Can you write a fact-file about this person?	<b><u>Geography</u></b> Can you draw a simple map to show your walk to school? Label some of the features on your walk. (e.g. post box, zebra crossing, newsagents.)
	Write a series of sentences that is exactly 30 words about anything you would like. (Something you have done, an animal, a person, a favourite toy)	Cut out pictures from a magazine/newspaper and then cut them into halves Stick them in your learning log and label with half.	<b><u>RE</u></b> Retell a story that shows what Christians might think about Jesus e.g the loaves and the fishes, healing the blind man, walking on water, Jesus and the children, Lazarus, Jairus' daughter.	<b><u>Geography</u></b> Create a simple map of your dream town. Label the buildings you have drawn. What will you include in your dream town? Shops, play areas, swimming pool, bowling alley etc.
