It must be in the style of a WWI poster.</p>	<p><u>History/ English</u></p> <p>Write a newspaper report about the outbreak of the war - look at the example in class on our WWI table to help you.</p>	<p><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>Make your own 3D model linked to WWI - a trench, No Man's Land...etc.</p>

On the computer, you may want to use publisher or word or something</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Write a diary entry from the perspective of a soldier in the trenches.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Using chalks or paints create a piece of artwork representing the battlefield.</p>	<p><u>History/English</u></p> <p>Prepare a lesson to teach the class about an aspect of WWI you enjoy (Be ready to teach it!)</p>
