<u>History/English</u> Create a fact file on a famous Tudor.	<u>History</u> Create an illustrated timeline for the Tudor Period.	<u>History/ Art</u> Learn about Henry VIII's six wives and make a booklet about them. Draw a sketch of each of their portraits.	<u>Maths</u> Create a bar chart to show how long each of the Tudor monarchs reigned. Create another to show how old the monarchs were when they died. Create at least 4 questions that can be answered from your charts.
<u>Design and Technology/Art</u> Important Tudor families often have their own family symbol (e.g. The Tudor Rose or The Three Feathers of The Prince of Wales). Design a symbol for your own family, making sure it reflects your family in some way. Explain why you have chosen this symbol.	<u>Art/Computing</u> Tudors liked to use something called illuminated letters, they were colourful and detailed. Investigate the use of illuminated letters. Illuminate your initials.	<u>History/ English</u> Decide on a person you would like to know more about from the Tudor times. Use as many sources to find out all about them. Write and draw about them. What is your opinion of them?	<u>English</u> Create a short presentation for the class on an aspect of Tudor England that interests you, such as music, illness and cures/ medicine, food or crime and punishment.
<u>Computing</u> Make a front cover for your Tudor section of your topic book. On the computer, you may want to use Publisher or Word or you may want to do it by hand!	<u>Art/ English</u> Design menus fit for a King or Queen, (remember Tudor meals for rich people were enormous and lasted for several hours!).	<u>Art</u> Find out about Tudor fashion and create some pictures/ a booklet. Choose any kind of medium (e.g. paint, collage, pencils).	<u>History/English</u> Find out about the Battle of Bosworth Fields and write a newspaper report as if you were a reporter back in Tudor times. When was the battle? Who won the battle? Why was the outcome of the battle so important?
<u>Art</u> Rich Tudors liked to have lots of portraits of themselves. Can you do one for yourself?	<u>Maths</u> Ask as many people as possible to name Henry VIII wives. Make a bar chart showing how many people knew 1 name, 2 names...all the way to six names.	<u>Science/ English</u> Find out about Tudor inventions that interest you. Compare them to the present day. Decide on an interesting way of presenting your findings.	<u>History</u> Find out about your own family history and make your own family tree.
