Please spend some time discussing the following activities with your child. All of the activities are linked to our topic.

Go on a minibeast hunt in your garden. Write a list of/take photos/draw the minibeasts you find.	Ask people what their favourite minibeast is. Make a tally chart. Which one is the most popular?	Use minibeast legs to make some maths sums. e.g 1 spider plus 1 bee= 8+6=14. 1 bee add 1 bee =6+6=12
Make a snack for a hungry caterpillar.	Look up some facts about a minibeast. Write some of the facts that you have found out.	Paint a picture or make a 3D model of a minibeast/ or paint some pebbles to make them look like minibeasts.
Read the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and write a book review.	Design your own minibeast and label it.	Make a role play Garden centre - make flowers/plants, and label them with prices, use real coins to pay for them.
