Dear Parents / Carers,

Many thanks to you all for bearing with us during this difficult week. As you can appreciate, our school found out about the national lockdown at the same time as you did on Monday evening. Luckily, we were quite prepared with work on the website anticipating the likelihood of some children being off for isolation. However, we are conscious that school is

expected to provide the opportunity for 3-4 hours of learning per day, we will of course be adding to this material ready for when it is required.

For some, I know that this is all feeling very over-whelming. We have put information about home learning together which meets our legal duty but have underlined the point that it needs to fit round families own situations! Many families will and can engage. However, for others, for many complex reasons, it is more challenging. We are here to support and are realistic about how this will be and that some children/families will struggle. We will not be insisting on any 'one-size fits all' expectation but will work with families to help with their circumstances.

We have suggested the number of hours as this has come from central government. Whilst the recommendations are the ideal, life is far from ideal at the moment!! Just do what you can and try not to panic. We will be here to respond to individual circumstances and offer our ongoing support and assistance. Please utilise the administration email for your child's class to send us their completed work. All work should be sent in by midday on Friday. The documentation sent out earlier this week specifies how much work we are expecting to receive. Teachers will then offer written feedback to pupil's individually via a feedback sheet. This will be sent back to parents via the class administration email by close of the following Monday. This email is for administrative purposes only, so teachers will only be offering feedback via the feedback sheet. If you have any specific issues that require addressing, please continue to email ellison.d@wlearn365.com, and as per our last lockdown I will be working to ensure you receive a swift response to your enquiries

We understand face-to-face contact with your child's class teacher is going to be really useful for keeping pupils motivated, for keeping in touch and for giving feedback on previous work. Therefore, in amendment to our previous message on this matter, we will be offering parents the option of requesting telephone contact or an online meeting, much the same way as the recent Parent Consultations, moving forward. This is something the school is busy working on, and further information will be coming to parents shortly about this. We will be facilitating such contact broadly every 10 days from week beginning 18th January 2021. In the meantime, all parents will be contacted by the class teacher via telephone to check on how things are going for you all.

We will also be ensuring that teachers are including video clips at the start of each fortnight to introduce the work set on the website. Alongside these, teachers will also occasionally include some videos e.g., story sessions as appropriate. Staff and I will also continue to be visible to you all in the various video messages and fun activities we post on our Facebook page. You don't need to be on Facebook to access, you can still view content on the homepage of website.

I have been asked by some parents about the distribution of IT equipment. Prior to this school closure, schools were allocated a small number of laptops that could be claimed in the event of large bubble closure. Our school were allocated 6 laptops by the government but were not able to claim this allocation due to us being successful in containing and controlling the virus e.g., our school ensured that we did not have to close a whole class/year group in the event of a positive COVID test.

Since the mass closure of schools has been announced again, the government issued more information about how schools could apply for technology to support families. The school is currently trying to navigate this information and find out exactly what we are entitled to claim. Please bear with us, and please understand the issues are complex. Bandwidth, the lack of devices in a home, no access to a device at all, and varying parental confidence with IT has all got to be taken into consideration, so there is not a straightforward solution. Please also bear in mind, that there is often a delay with what is announced in parliament and the reality on the ground!

Considering these issues, and in line with what the school's current duties are, we are offering a 'Remote and Blending Learning' approach which is deliberately designed for all children, regardless of their home circumstances. There is a clear and evident balance between online learning and learning that can be undertaken without the use of the internet.

Finally, today I want to express our deepest regret regarding the situation our country finds itself in. We are saddened that we are not able to keep our doors open to all pupils. However, as always we will do our very best to support you all, whilst keeping our staff and community safe.

We wish you all a safe and happy first lockdown weekend!


