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| <p><u>Times Tables ~ Mini Tests</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Think of a times table to practice. 2. Write out the multiplication and answer and the associated division fact. Eg. $3 \times 9 = 27$ and $27 \div 9 = 3$ 3. Get someone at home to check it then test you each day. <p>Practice: Test each day until you are scoring 100%</p> <p>Challenge: Try to get faster and answer questions in random order</p> | <p><u>Place Value ~ Round to 10, 100 and 1000</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask anyone at home to help you think of ten 5-digit numbers. 2. Write the numbers down. 3. Round all the numbers to the nearest ten. 4. Round all the numbers to the nearest hundred 5. Round the numbers to the nearest 1000 <p>Practice: Get ten new numbers and try again another time</p> <p>Challenge: Try 6-digit numbers rounded to 10, 100 & 1000</p> | <p><u>Place Value ~ Ordering</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask anyone at home to help you think of ten 5-digit numbers. 2. Write the numbers down. 3. Order the numbers from smallest to largest (ascending order) 4. Order the numbers from largest to smallest (descending order) 5. Work out the difference between each number <p>Practice: Get ten new numbers and try again another time</p> <p>Challenge: Try 6-digit numbers ordered.</p> | <p><u>Place Value ~ what's my number?</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Player 1 (You or another player from home) chooses a number. 2. Player 2 asks questions to help work out the secret number 3. Player one can only answer yes or no <p>Example</p> <p>Player 2 "Is it over 50?" Player 1 "Yes"</p> <p>Practice: Choose numbers each day</p> <p>Challenge: guess the number with 7 questions.</p> |
| <p><u>Calculation ~ Countdown</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Think of a target number (3654) 2. Using the digits 0-9 and the operations + - \times \div, write a set of calculations and try to make the make the number <p>Only use each digit once. You can use the operations more than once</p> <p>Practice: Pick a new target number each day and try again</p> <p>Challenge: Try and get faster or try and do less calculations</p> | <p><u>Calculation ~ Addition/Subtraction</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Make up ten 6-digit numbers. 2. Choose two to add together. 3. Can you then write a worded problem for this? 4. Repeat again with two of your other numbers. <p>Challenge: Repeat the challenge but this time with subtraction!</p> | <p><u>Calculation ~ Addition</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Start with the Got It target 234. 2. Each player chooses a whole number from 1 to 4 . 3. Players take turns to add a whole number from 1 to 4 to the running total. 4. The player who hits the target of 23 wins the game. <p>Practice: Pick a different number each day and try again</p> <p>Challenge: Try with higher totals</p> | <p><i>What could the question be if the answer is 64?</i></p> <p><u>Calculation</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Focus on the question above 2. Write as many calculations as to answer it <p>Practice: Pick a different number for the answer each day and try again</p> <p>Challenge: Just use multiplication and division.</p> |

Spellings ~ Mini Tests

1. Choose a set of spellings, to practice, from the spelling sheet
2. Write them out in a list
3. Get someone at home to check it then test you each day.

Practice: Test each day until you are scoring 100%

Challenge: Use these in sentences or a story

Spellings ~ Hangman

1. Choose a spelling from the spelling sheet
2. Write dashes for the number of letters _ _ _ _
3. Get a partner to guess the letters then spelling.

Practice: You always do the guessing

Challenge: Ignore the list and choose adventurous words.

SPAG ~ Direct speech

1. Write down a conversation you have had with someone at home.
2. Use inverted commas to punctuate and set out the speech accurately - remember new line new speaker!

Practice: pick a different conversation and try again

Challenge: Write a short story with direct speech in it. Can you use interesting adverbs in the reporting clauses?

SPAG ~ Adverbs.

1. Choose an appropriate TV program or film
2. Watch 10 minutes and Write down as many actions (verbs) as possible
3. Think of an accurate adverb for each action

Example BFG

Slept peacefully, woke suddenly, walked quietly

Practice: pick a different clip and try again

Challenge: Write the action and adverb in a sentence or a whole paragraph.

Reading ~ Reviews

1. Choose a new book to read or a favourite you have read
2. Write a letter to the author telling him/her what you like about the book.

Practice: pick another book and try again

Challenge: Imagine you are the author and write a reply!

Stories ~ Comic strip

1. Choose a book to read or an appropriate film to watch
2. Create a comic strip retelling the story.

Practice: pick another book/film and try again

Challenge: Try to use amazing adjectives and adverbs as in the SPAG tasks.

Stories ~ Writing

1. Choose a book to read or an appropriate film to watch
2. Re-write the complete story

Practice: pick another book/film and try again

Challenge: Try to use amazing adjectives and adverbs as in the SPAG tasks.

Non-chronological reports: Writing

1. Choose a subject you know a lot about e.g. The Tudors, Space, Dinosaurs.
2. Write a report, using subheadings and paragraphs to organise your information

Practice: pick another subject and try again

Challenge: Add pictures to add interest to your report.
